Minutes of meetings of July 28 1928 Aug 8 1928

 were read and confirmed.

A quotation submitted by the Clyde Printing Works for printing the Rules & Bye-Laws of the Centre was considered - the quotation of £2.15/- for 250 copies was accepted.

Arrangements for meetings for remainder of Session was next considered.

A letter was read from Mr Broughton offering a paper on Large Reflecting Telescopes for the April Meeting and Mr MacKenzie offered to submit a paper by Mr King on the daylight meters of July 27 1928. Both were accepted.

Mr Mc Intyre was asked and agreed to address the June Meeting. No arrangements were made for the May meeting, it being resolved to ask members attending the April meeting to make provision.

A letter was read from the Medical Association of South Africa intimating that the rent of the room used by the Society for their meetings would be increased to £15 per annum from June next.

In the discussion which followed Mr Long mentioned that he thought the room of the Mountain Club a long shaft would be available for meetings of the Society. He thought the room very suitable a great advantage being that there was always

an Epidiascope in position which could be used for lectures. The Hon Secretary said he had also inspected the room and thought it quite suitable, but there appeared to be no place for the book cases. No quotation for rent had been given but it was thought that it would not exceed £1 per meeting. It was resolved that if satisfactory arrangements could be made and the rent did not exceed £1 per meeting, to hold the meetings here after June. The medical practitioner's letter not being replied to till something definite was known.

The Secretary reported that the following members were three years in arrear with subscriptions:

To write to Mr C. B. Dutton regarding Mr J. B. Dutton & to call on Mr Williams.

It was resolved to purchase a set of stencils of names & addresses of members for the purpose of addressing envelopes.

The chairman proposed a vote of thanks to Mr Mrs Long for allowing the committee to meet at their residence, this was agreed to & the meeting terminated.
