

Observational Meeting

Held at the Royal Observatory (Cape 1)

on Sunday Evening February 23 1930. at 8.15 pm
By the kind invitation of His Majesty's Astronomer
S. H. Spencer Jones members assembled for observation
through the Victoria Telescope - The night unfortunately
was cloudy. Several attempts were made to observe
through breaks in the clouds, these however proved
unsatisfactory and the meeting dispersed.
