

Minutes of Emergency Meeting of Committee
Held at Benson House Long Street Wednesday
November 12. 1930 at 8 pm

Present Mr Horrocks in the chair Messrs
Fairbairn, Long, Mason, Pratt & the Hon Secretary
The Committee considered the resignation of the
Office of Treasurer by Mr A. F. J. Forbes, he
having left Cape Town to reside at Hermanus
Mr Long proposed that the resignation be accepted
this was agreed to. It was also resolved on the suggestion of

Mr Horrocks that a letter of thanks be sent to Mr
Forbes for his services to the Centre.

Mr Long said that he had ascertained that Mr Ridley
Shipman was willing to assume the duties of
Treasurer, in the Secretary's absence he had asked
Mr Shipman to take over the books from Mr Forbes
as a temporary measure, he now proposed that
Mr Shipman be appointed treasurer in the
place of Mr Forbes for the unexpired term of
the office.

This was agreed to & seconded by Mr Pratt and
agreed to unanimously

The Secretary was instructed to advise the
Bank of Mr Forbes resignation and of
the appointment of Mr Shipman to the
office of Treasurer.
