

Emergency meeting of the Committee
Held at the Royal Observatory Feb. 28. 1932

Present Mr H. Horrocks in the Chair Messrs
Leary Long, McDutye Pratt & the Hon Secretary.
The Secretary explained that the meeting had been
convened at the wish of the Hon Treasurer - Mr Pratt
in order to consider whether a loan should be made
from the funds of the Centre to the Society.

After discussion the Hon Secretary proposed that £10
be advanced to the Society - £5 as a donation, and
£5 as a loan to be repaid by the Society at a later
date.

Mr A. W. Long proposed as an amendment
that a donation of £10 be made to the Society
and that the Secretary of the Society be requested
to inform the Johannesburg ~~and~~ Centre that this
donation had been made by the Cape Centre in order
to meet the expenses incurred with the last issue
of the Journal and to ask the Johannesburg Centre
also to make a donation for the same purpose.
This was seconded by Mr Leary, and on being put
to vote was agreed to without dissent.
