The first part of the address dealt exhaustively
 with the Meteor Crater in Arizona, a detailed
 description being given of the general appearance,
 and ^{the} attempts that have been made to locate
 the mass that caused the crater. Similar
 craters that have been found in Australia
 and Arabia were also described, as were the
 effects of the great meteor that fell in Siberia
 in 1908. After discussion a hearty vote of thanks
 was passed to Mr Nankivell for his address and
 the meeting terminated.
