

## Astronomical Society of South Africa (Cape Centre)

A meeting of the Committee of the Cape Centre was held, by kind permission of Mr. Long, at Carnalea, Malleson Road, Mowbray on Wednesday the 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 1935, at 8.15 P. M.

Present: Messrs W. Andrews, R. R. Pratt, D. G. McIntyre, D. C. Burrell, A. W. Long and the Hon. Secretary.

The minutes of committee meetings held on Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup> 1934, 17<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1934, and the 15<sup>th</sup> May 1935, were read and confirmed.

The financial statement showed a credit balance of £9.14.6. The telescope fund showed a total of £8.11.6. Of the balance in hand, it was agreed to send a cheque for £5 to the Society, to contribute towards the cost of the next number of the Journal.
