Minutes of Committee Meeting held at the Royal Observatory at 8.15 P.M. on Monday April 4, 1938.

Present: Dr. Hoy (Chairman), Messrs Long, Linton, Andrews, Turner, ~~and~~ Capt. Cameron-Swan, and the Hon. Secretary.

The Minutes of Committee Meetings held on the 13th Oct 1937, and on 17th Nov 1937 were read and confirmed.

A letter ~~received~~ of resignation had been received by the Hon. Secretary from Mr. N. L. Blackmore. This resignation was accepted by the committee.

The Treasurer's statement was read by Mr. J. B. G. Turner and showed a balance of £13" 13" 10⁷.

The Committee dealt next with the names of members who were more than 2 years in arrears with their subscription. Mr. Long said that he would write to Mr. Deas (Associate), and the Rev. A. Graham. The Hon. Secretary was to write to Prof. Plummers and C. P. Hemphill.

The Chairman intimated that Dr. Jackson would be the speaker at the following Cape Centre Meeting on April 20th, the subject being "Astrographic work at the Cape Observatory". Mr. H. E. Houghton promised a paper for May, and the Secretary was instructed to invite Mr. J. G. Gray to speak at the meeting in June.

The meeting concluded with a hearty vote of thanks to Dr + Mrs Jackson for their hospitality.

The meeting decided, on the recommendation of Mr. Long, to send the Astronomical Times to Miss E. Smith of Weymouth, England.
