Minutes of Committee Meeting held at the Royal Observatory
at 8.15 P.M. on Monday the 27 June 1938.

Present: Dr. Stoy (Chairman), Messrs Long, Linton, Andrews, Schonegewel, Turner, C. E. Peers, Capt. Cameron-Swan, and the Hon. Secretary.

The Minutes of Committee Meetings held on the ~~20~~⁴th April and the 20th April 1938, were read and confirmed.

~~revised~~ The Treasurer's Statement read by Mr. Turner showed a balance of £3⁴⁰⁰, after all deductions had been made.

The resignations of the Rev. A. Graham, Dr. L. Crawford, and Mr. H. F. Mullis were accepted by the Committee.

Dr. Stoy informed the meeting that, ^{acting} on the suggestion of Mr. Turner, a letter had been forwarded by him to the Editor of the Cape Times, asking whether it would be possible to print reports of the Cape Centre's monthly meetings in the $\frac{1}{2}$ copies of the Cape Times which contained the Astronomical Notes. These reports would be of interest to Country Members.

The Committee approved of the action of the Chairman in sending the letter.

The draft Annual Report was read by the Hon. Secretary, and discussed by the meeting.

Mr. Watson had written to the Hon. Secretary that he would speak on "The Equation of Time" at the July meeting.

The meeting concluded with a hearty vote of thanks to Dr. Stoy for his hospitality.
