

Astronomical Society of South Africa (Cape Centre)

Minutes of Committee Meeting held at the Royal Observatory at 8.15 P.M. on Monday the 20th February 1939.

Present: Dr Jackson (Chairman) Messrs Linton, Andrews, Turner, Peers, and the Hon. Secretary. A letter of apology for absence received from ~~was read~~ Capt. Cannon-Craig, was read to the meeting. Mr. Long was prevented from attending, through ill-health.

The Minutes of Committee Meetings held on the 27th June 1938, 20th July 1938, 17th August 1938, and 16th November 1938 were read and confirmed.

Mr. Turner read the Treasurer's statement, which showed a balance of £6 10/- at 20th 2/39.

The resignations of Messrs A. Pilling and D. T. Roux were accepted by the Committee.

It was resolved, on the suggestion of Dr. Jackson, to change the Postal address of the Cape Centre to the Royal Observatory, instead of P.O. Box 2061.

It was decided that Mr. D. G. McIntyre be asked to speak at the March meeting of the Centre, Mr. Houghton & Mr. Reed in ~~April~~^{June}, and Dr. J. Jackson in May. Professor James was to be invited to lecture in April. Some of the meetings were to be of an instructional nature, such as ^{lectures on} elementary astronomy. This concluded the business for the evening.
