Minutes of Committee Meeting held at the Royal Observatory at 8.15 P.M. on Wednesday the 23rd August 1939.

Present: Mr. Schonegevel (in the Chair) Dr. Jackson, Messrs Krumm, Andrews, Turner, Reed, and the Hon. Secretary. Mr. Hirst tendered his apologies for ^{his} absence, through Mr. Krumm.

The Minutes of Committee Meetings held on the 12th June, 21st June, and the 19th July were read and confirmed.

Mr. Turner reported a balance in hand of $\pounds 19 - \overset{12}{\cancel{15}} - \overset{2}{\cancel{2}}$. It was decided to repay the remaining $\pounds 5$ owing on the Telescope, to Mr. Long.

It was agreed that the Hon. Secretary should write to members who were two years in arrears with subscriptions.

Dr. Jackson agreed to write to Dr. Shipley to ask him to deliver an address to the Cape Centre in September, should he be in the Cape at that time. The speakers at the next meetings would be Dr. Jackson, Mr. Reed, Dr. Lloy, and Mr. H.W. Schonegevel.
