Minutes of Committee meeting held at the Royal Observatory at 8.15 P.M. on Monday the 18th March 1940.

Present: Mr Schonegevel (in the Chair) Dr. Jackson, Messrs Andrews, Turner, Hirst, Reed, Capt. Cameron Mann, and the Hon. Secretary.

Mr. Krumm tendered his apologies for absence. Dr. Hoy was ~~also~~ unable to be present, and tendered his apologies.

The Minutes of Committee Meeting held on the 23rd August 1939 were read and confirmed.

The Treasurer, Mr. Turner, reported a balance in hand of £4-2/11.

It was agreed to ask ~~the~~ Mr. Linton to speak at the April meeting, Mr. Houghton for May, Mr. G.H. Menzies for June, Dr. Jackson for July, and Prof. Walker for August.

It was decided to leave the Centre's telescope with Mrs. Long for the present, and to discover Mrs. Long's wishes in relation to the future housing of the instrument.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
