Twenty-eighth Session

Minutes of eighth ordinary meeting of the Session, held at the Royal Observatory on Wednesday the 10th June 1942 at 8.15 P.M.

Dr. Jackson presided. The attendance was fair. Mr. H.C. Davies, who had been away from Cape Town for some years, was present at the meeting, and was rejoining the Society.

The Chairman informed the meeting that owing to ill-health and the prevailing stormy weather, Mr. A.F. Forbes was unable to be present to deliver his talk on the 200" telescope.

The Minutes of Ordinary meeting held on the 13th May 1942 were read and after an amendment, confirmed.

The Hon. Secretary was instructed to convey the thanks of members to Mr. Forbes for the time and trouble taken by him in the construction of a model of the 200" telescope, which had been forwarded to Cape Town from Hermannus.

Members were told that the next meeting of the Centre would be the Annual General Meeting, to be held on the 15th July 1942.
