Held at Royal Observatory

Present: Mr. W.F.T. Schirach, in the Chair; Messrs B. H. Dibbitts, R.F. Irembaek, R.J. Johnston, CA. Lake, R. B. Borchardt and ~~the~~ J.B. Jones. An apology for absence was received from Mr. H.C. Davies.

The minutes of the Committee Meeting held on 1950 February 22 were read and adopted.

In connection with the presentation to be made later in the evening to Dr. and Mrs. Jackson the Hon. Treasurer stated that a total sum of £12.10.0 had been subscribed by members.
