

Minutes of a Committee meeting held at the Royal Observatory on 10.9.52.

The Chairman of the Centre Dr. Evans presided.

Present: Messrs Krumm, Johnston, Christ, Cousins, Painsyck, Tibbitts and Borchards

Mr. Menzies was in attendance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Discussion of the programme resulted in agreement as follows:-
