

Minutes of Committee Meeting; held at the  
Royal Observatory on Wednesday 18th February, 1959.

Present :- Mr. P. Smith in the Chair, Messrs Bentley  
Chambers, Johnston, Tibbitts, Weinberg & the Hon. Sec.

Apologies for absence were received from Messrs. Meadows, Knudsen & Gillingham.  
The minutes of the previous meeting were read  
and confirmed.

In the absence of the Treasurer, the Secretary stated  
that the Centre's credit balance had remained  
at £47.14.9.

A provisional programme of lectures for the  
remainder of the year was then drawn up.  
These were to comprise one by Mr. P. Seligmann on 'Time  
and Observatory Instrumentation'; one by Dr. Taylor  
on 'Meteors'; one by Mr. Baudenstein on 'Photography';  
and a lecture by Mr. Alexander. These lectures  
were not tied down to definite dates, pending the  
availability of the lecturers.

A new Rota of those who were to assist  
at visitors' evenings was drawn up. The subject  
of reorganization of the evenings, with the possible  
institution of a ticket system, was brought up,  
but it was decided to approach Her Majesty's Astronomer  
should circumstances warrant it.

There being no further business, the meeting  
adjourned.
