

Minutes of the Committee Meeting held at  
the Royal Observatory on Saturday, 6th February, 1960,  
immediately before the Observational Evening

Present:- Mr. W. C. Bentley in the Chair,

Manor Knum, Loon, Rodger, Russo, Sante  
Cham, Meadows, and the Hon. Secretary.

An Apology for absence was received from Mr. Einleboff.  
The minutes of the previous Committee Meeting  
were read and approved.

The Hon. Secretary announced that he had  
received two applications for membership of the  
Society, which he would forward to the Society  
Secretary with the Committee's approval.

A provisional programme for the remainder of  
the 1960 session was then drawn up. It was  
proposed that Dr. ~~Hawke~~, Stay and Fennie  
be approached with regard to their lecturing,  
depending on their availability. As Dr. Thackeray,  
of the Radcliffe Observatory had expressed his willingness  
to address the Centre during his visit to the Cape  
at the end of February, it was decided to  
hold a special Centre meeting at which he would  
speak, on the 24th. The Honorary Secretary  
would inform Centre members by way of a special circular,  
as MNASA would not be ready in time.

A new role of members who would assist at  
Victoria evening meetings was drawn up. The Committee  
then discussed a request by a Centre member, Mr  
T. Bodenham, that a move be made to establish an  
amateur telescope makers group. It was decided that  
Centre members be asked at Meetings and through MNASA  
that those interested submit their names to the Secretary.  
There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8 p.m.
