

Minutes of the Ordinary General Meeting of the ^{CCPP} Centre held at the Observatory at 8.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 13th September, 1972.

Mr W. Greenwood presided with a good attendance of members and visitors.

Apologies were received from Messrs Dardetti, Allan and Neale, (Hon. Secretary). Mr R.F. Harley took the minutes in the absence of the secretary.
