Mr Hurly also reported that he had been giving talks on astronomy to various local schools.

Mr Orpen reported that Paul Roos-Gimnasium had approached him for suggestions for observing programms that they could undertake. They have a fifteen inch Newtonian. The Society's secretary was to attend to the matter.

The Chairman then announced some future meetings. The next meeting would be in 1975 February, when Professor Warner would address the Centre, and in March a visit to the Cape Town Planetarium was planned.

However, before the February meeting, a farewell party for Mr and Mrs Harding would be held on Wednesday 1974 December 18 at 20 hours. All members and their wives or husbands were invited. Invitations were to be sent out.

The Chairman then introduced Mr Hurly, the guest speaker for the He apologised for the change from the scheduled speaker, Mr Harding, and said that Mr Harding had returned from Sutherland earlier that evening. The Chairman thanked Mr Hurly for agreeing to speak at short notice.

Mr Hurly gave an interesting talk detailing the many satellites which had been placed in orbit. He also mentioned the Earth Resources Technology Satellite and explained the uses to which it was put, evidenced by a book of maps of South Africa which had been produced from photographs Mr Hurly's talk was followed by two sound films taken by this satellite. dealing with the ERTS and Skylab.
