

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE CAPE CENTRE OF THE ASTRONOMICAL  
SOCIETY OF SOUTHERN AFRICA HELD AT THE CAPE TOWN PLANETARIUM  
ON WEDNESDAY 1975 MARCH 12 AT 20 h 00
