held at SAAP on Wed 9th Nov. 1977 at 8 pm.

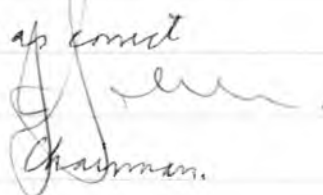
Present 26 Members and 4 Visitors
