

Minutes of a meeting of the Council of the Astronomical Society of South Africa, held at the Royal Observatory, Cape of Good Hope, on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June 1933, at 8-15 pm.

Present

Mr Long in the chair, Messrs Andrew, McIntyre, Peers, Pratt, Schonegevel, Smith and the Hon Sec.

Capt. Cameron Swan sent apologies for being unable to attend, and Messrs Gearey, Mason and Burnell were away from Capetown.

Mr Wood had invited Mr Peers to act as alternate in the absence of Mr Mason.

Minutes

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Durban Branch A copy of their resolution by which the amalgamation was effected had been received. It was agreed to ask for a copy of their rules and by-laws.

Huschel Memorial - The secretary reported that the Town Clerk had replied to his inquiry saying that the registration of the title to the reserve etc was receiving attention. The subcommittee was empowered to approach other bodies in the name of the Society with a view to their co-operating to form a general committee to organise centenary activities.

Pamphlet

The Journal Committee reported that the pamphlet containing the account of the presentation to Dr Spencer Jones had been printed and was ready for distribution. It was decided to send a dozen copies to Mr Spencer Jones.

Mathematical Section Ten people had expressed willingness to cooperate. On the proposal of Mr Schonegevel seconded by Mr Pratt it was agreed to form such a section and to appoint Mr Allerton as director.

The Financial Statement showed a balance of £ 21-14-6.

Journal Committee. There was nothing further to report. It was agreed that a supply of the last issue of the Journal should be sent to Durban for distribution to the Natal members.
