Minutes of Council Meeting held at the Royal Observatory on Thursday the 30th January 1941. at 8.15 P.M.

The Minutes of Council Meeting held on the 29th July 1940 were read and confirmed.

The Financial Statement showed a balance in hand of £38-7-10.

It was decided that owing to the weak financial position, the printing of the Journal be postponed to some future date. Capt. Cameron-Swan suggested that under Clause (a) in the "Abel Bailey Trust" the Astronomical Society appeared to have a prospect of obtaining an annual grant to defray ~~cost~~ ^{the} a part of the cost of printing the Journal. Capt. Cameron-Swan was to find out the exact wording of Clause 'A', and to report at the next Council Meeting.

On Mr. Turner's suggestion it was agreed that a list of books in the Society's library be circulated to members, together with ~~a~~ conditions on which these could be borrowed.

The Hon. Secretary was instructed to write to Mr. de Kock conveying the congratulations of the Council on his discovery of a comet.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
