Minutes of Council Meeting held at the Royal Observatory on Friday
16th July at 8 P.M.

Present: Mr Hirst (in the Chair) Messrs Turner, Krumm, Orben, Davies,
Borchards, de Kock and the Hon. Secretary.

Apologies for absence had been received from Messrs Johnston and Schi-
rach, and from Dr Stoy.

* The Financial Statement read by Mr Krumm showed a balance
in hand of £63.12.8.

The following new Members were elected: Mr. R. Oxley-Oxland,
P.O. Norlim, via Taung, C.P., for Mr. Meyers, re. Dr. Stoy; Mr. A.
F. Barwick, "Cranley", Chudleigh Rd., Plumstead.

The election of Mrs. A.M. Cousins, Royal Observatory, Obser-
vatory, for Miss Flux, re. Mr. Turner, as an Associate of the Cape
Centre, was confirmed by the Council.

The draft Annual Report was considered and passed by
the Council.

It was decided to postpone consideration of a grant
to the Port Elizabeth Telescope Fund until September or
October 1948.

No further nominations had been received, and the
Officers and Council to be elected on the 26th May at a Council
meeting held at the Royal Observatory, would be elected at
the Annual General Meeting on 28th July.

This ended the business for the evening.

Bushnell + Milne, while Mr. S. Robertson becomes an Associate
instead of a full Member.
