Minutes of Council Meeting held at the Royal Observatory on Thursday
April 19 1951 at 8 P.M.

Apologies for absence had been received from Messrs Kruun, who was indisposed, and Prof. Mengier.

Minutes: The Minutes of Council Meeting held on the 7th February 1951 were read and confirmed.
