

Astronomical Society of South Africa
Minutes of Council Meeting held at the Royal Observatory on
Monday June 4, 1951.

Apologies for absence had been received from Messrs Hirst and
Coxinus.

Present: Mr Kramm (in the Chair) Dr. Stoy, Messrs Schirach,
Johnston, Turner, Orpen, Davies, Prof. Mengies and the Hon. Secretary.

The Minutes of Council Meeting held on the 19th April 1951 were
read and confirmed.

Rising out of the Minutes, Mr. Orpen moved, seconded by
Mr. Johnston, that the publication of Mr. Finsen's address in 'Popu-
lar Astronomy' be proceeded with. This was agreed to.

The Financial Statement read by Mr. Orpen showed a balance
of £125, and was adopted by the meeting.

The election of W. E. Cowley, 43 First Avenue, Linden, Johan-
nesburg as a Student Member of the Jo'Burg Centre was con-
firmed, as also the election of Miss G. W. Goldschmidt, 17
Isipingo St., Bellevue, Johannesburg as an Associate.
