Minutes of Council Meeting held at the Royal Observatory on Tuesday 29th January 1957 at 8.00p.m.

Present: Dr. Stoy in the chair, Dr. Evans, Dr. Cousins, Professor Menzies, Messrs Krumm, Johnston, Borcherds, Linton, Duncan, Orpen and the Hon. Secretary. Apologies for absence were received from Messrs Hirst, Turner and Russo.

The Minutes of Council Meeting held on the 29th October 1956 were read and confirmed after a correction to the name of Mr. P. Angus-Leppan.

Arising out of the Minutes the Hon. Secretary reported the receipt from Turban of a list of the office-bearers of the Natal Centre.

Dr. Cousins had been asked by the Natal Centre to act for that Centre as their representative on the Council. It was decided however to ask Mr. C.D. Thompson, of Cepia, Hampton Avenue, Newlands to act as the Alternate to the Council representative to be appointed by Natal.
