read and after amendments, adopted.

The ballet on the award of the Gill Medal was unanimously in favour of the award to Mr.W.P. Hirst, and of the Citation:
"For outstanding services to South African Astronomy as a computer, observer, writer and lecturer.

Mr. Hirst is an amateur with an obsorbing profession and wide interests, but in spite of this he has become an astronomical

computer of high standing and his contributions to our journal outnumber those of any other author, amateur or professional. Nor have his contributions been confined to M. N. A. S. S. A. He has computed orbits for several comets about a dozen asteroids and some double stars. His articles on Orbits Computing are worthy of the closest study. His observing has been concentrated on occultations and double stars. The work of Mr. Hirst is a demon-stration of the level of achievement that can be attained by a gifted amateur".

Mr.Russo informed the meeting that Dr. Thackeray was not in favour of the award of the Gill Medal as an annual event, but would have the award every second year.
