It was agreed that a letter be sent to the Commissioners of Inland Revenue, Somerset House, London, requesting that subscriptions to the Society by members liable to United Kingdom tax, be recognised as a claim for deduction against this tax.

Mr. Meadows was asked to write to Mr. Ottens to the effect that two missing sketches could be reproduced for inclusion in copies of the article on Telescope-making, at Mr. Ottens' expense.

Mr. Russo was asked to write to the Johannesburg Centre to ask for a nomination as Director for the Meteor Section, and to request that the Society's Treasurer be informed of payments received from Transvaal members as soon as possible.

Dr. Haffner spoke on the difficulties encountered in forming a Bloemfontein Centre. A copy of the Cape Centre's Constitution was handed to Dr. Haffner, who expressed thanks to members for suggestions received from them on the subject under discussion.
