The Hon. Secretary was asked to obtain from the General Post Office the regulations governing the registration of publications as a newspaper.

It was agreed that £2 be spent on collating the Monthly Notes for December and January.

The Hon. Secretary was asked to send the Sedaven Astronomical Society a copy of the Monthly Notes, Sky and Telescope, the Handbook, and a Nomination Form.

The appointment of a Director of the Computing Section was discussed, and Mr. van Zyl of the Transvaal was mentioned as a candidate for the position.

Drs. Thackeray and Feast were elected to represent the Society at a conference to be held at Pretoria by the C.S.I.R., on the publication of the results of research.
