Minutes of Council Meeting held at the Royal Observatory on Monday 20th June 1966 at 8.00 p.m.

Present: Mr. Menzies (in the Chair), Messrs Orpen, Bentley, Atkins, Bondietti, Weinberg, Churms, Smits, Meadows, Russo, Drs. Cousins and Fuhr.

Apologies for absence for Mr. Lagerweij, and Dr. Stoy, presently overseas, were noted.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on 11th May 1966 were read, and after the inclusion of Dr. Fuhr's name among "Apologies for absence", were confirmed and signed.

Arising out of the minutes, Mr. Bentley confirmed that 310 copies of "Sky and Telescope" had been ordered as from the July issue.

Regarding the McIntyre Bequest, a recent letter from Syfrets Trust was read, in which it was intimated that the deceased's main investment, a participation in a Mortgage Bond of R2300 was fixed until 31st August, 1969. In order to facilitate the early winding up of the Estate, it was agreed to advise Syfrets Trust that the Society would be prepared to take over as portion of its inheritance one-half of the said Mortgage Bond participation, and that necessary notice be given for repayment on 31st August 1969.
