Minutes

of the previous meeting held January 29, 1973, which had been circulated, were taken as read and adopted.

Astronomy as part of the School curriculum: Mr Bosdietti Matters arising spoke at some length on enquiries he had made. Three of the schools he had contacted were in favour of the teaching of astronomy. There appeared to be two possible ways of introducing the subject. Firstly by having it form part or an extension of a present existing subject, like physics, or secondly by introducing it as a separate additional subject on a school's cirriculum. This latter course would require teachers specially qualified. It was mentioned that a new physics course would become operative in 1974. After some discussion the matter was left over for the next Council meeting. Mr. Harding thanked Mr. Bosdietti for the time and thought given.
