Any Further Business:

- (a) Miss Booth raised the question of the Constitution of the Cape Centre, which had been forwarded to the Hon. Secretary for Councils approval. On Mr Turk's recommendation this was accepted. It was agreed that all Centre constitutions submitted to Council should be vetted by Mr Turk.
- (b) Mr Turk reported on the financial position of the Trust Fur This was now producing an income, which could be used fur Society purposes. As a start the shortfall on the Essay Competition prizes, provided by the McIntyre Fund, could be met in this way.
- (c) The Hon. Secretary read a letter received from Mr G Larmuth, intimating that he wished to terminate his mailing of M.N.A.S.S.A to subscribers, with the end of volume 38 and the 1980 Handbook. He had undertaken this task for five years & considered that the time was ripe for someone else to take over. Dr Feast expressed Councils appreciation of what had been done over such a long period of time, and called for suggestions for a successor. This was not fruitful, and members were asked to consider the matter seriously and endeavour to be in a position to appoint someone by the next meeting.
- (d) Mr Burke stated that he would be transferring to Johannesburg after the end of November, and would no longer be in a position to act as an alternate for Mr Vincent of Salizzar,
- (e) Mr Churms had asked that the Advertising Rates in M.N.A.S.S.A. should be increased as follows:
