Minutes of Council Meeting held on 1984 January 30 at 20h00 at SAAO Cape Town

1. Present

Mr. J. Bondietti in the Chair, Professor W.M.Feast, Dr.A.W.J.Cousins, Dr.Peter Mack, Miss P.Booth, Messrs W.C.Bentley, W.Neilson, F.N.G.Orpen (Hon. Treasurer) M.G.Soltynski, C.Turk and the Hon. Secretary H.E.Krumm.

2. Apologies

Apologies for absence were received from Messrs R.Hurly, J.Simenhoff and J.Spencer Jones. Professor A.P.Fairall's apologies were accepted for absence on sabbatical leave overseas during 1984. Up-country members automatically accepted.

3. Minutes

Minutes of previous Council Meeting held on 1983 November 7 at 20h00 at SAAO, copies of which had been circulated, were taken as read, confirmed and signed.

4. Matters arising from the Minutes

- (i) Minute No.4(iv) Council Meeting 1983 June 13

 Recognition of Long Service to the Society. Except for a reply from Mr. M.A.Gray, no further suggestions had been received. It was agreed to go back to Mr.Gray and to ask him whether he would be prepared to draw up a list of proposals to enable Council to crystallize this somewhat long outstanding matter.
- (ii) Minute No.7(ii) Reimbursement of Directors of Observing Sections.

 Mr.C.Turk reported that he had not met Mr.D.Overbeek during his recent visit to the Cape although he had spoken to him over the telephone. Mr. Overbeek's only comments were that a decision should be taken in principle.

 After a short discussion it was agreed to inform the Directors of the Observing Sections that they were at liberty to apply at any time, and as they felt the need, for thereimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses.

 Applications must be submitted to Council for consideration.
- (iii) Minute No.8. McIntyre Award-Presentation. The McIntyre Award was presented to Professor Brian Warner at a function held at the SAAO on Friday 6 January 1984 at 20h00. It was a very successful occasion attended by about 50 members and guests. Mr.M.G.Soltynski was thanked for making the arrangements and obtaining the wine and the eats. Council approved the payment of R76-51 to Mr.Soltynski for out-of-pocket expenses.

5. Finance

The Hon. Treasurer presented his Financial Statement, a copy of which is attached to these minutes. The Statement showed a credit balance of R447-59 and was adopted.

6. Membership: Resignations and Suspensions

The Hon. Treasurer reported that 32 members had resigned since July 1984. Originally 30 had been suspended for non-payment of subscriptions but 8 have now paid their dues and have been reinstated. The influx of new members has tended to stabilise the Membership Roll which now stands at 466.

8. ASSET

Neither an account nor the dies accompanied the medals. The Hon. Secretary was asked to mention the matter concerning the dies when paying the account.

It was stated that the delay in the appearance of the present issue was due to the late arrival of the annual reports of two Centres of the Society. Council was deeply appreciative of the work being done by Messrs Churms and Spencer Jones but it was obvious that they would require additional help if MNASSA were to appear more often and at regular intervals. It was agreed to ask Mr.Churms to attend the next meeting of Council for discussions.
