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### Honorary Treasurer's Report for the Financial Year 2000 - 2001.

Your society continues to prosper under difficult conditions of dropping Rand value and inexorable cost increases, and a surplus of R10000 is shown in the unaudited accounts for the financial year just ended.

Of some interest, but of little significance is that our annual income has exceeded the six figure mark for the first time, mainly due to the spiralling cost in Rands of members subscriptions to Sky and Telescope, which accounted for R28000 of the R30000 increase in income.

Other expenses have been well controlled, and it will be seen that the costs of badges and banners have been written off in the amount of R6000.

The scholarship account has grown to R42000, so that renewed efforts are called for to attract candidates.

## Honorary Treasurer's Report to Council on Tuesday 15 February 2000.

Substantial expenditure on Sky & Telescope payments (R8000 from receipts in the first quarter), Mnassa production expenses (R7000 in respect of last two issues of 1999 year) and Handbook production (R6500 for 1200 copies) resulted in a hefty deficit for the second quarter of R18000.

This illustrates how prudent accounting causes large fluctuations in any quarter, so the year to date surplus of R10000 is a truer reflection of the current financial situation.

Not included in the surplus are amounts of R8500 received in respect of the current calendar year from overseas subscribers to Mnassa and a windfall receipt of R3500 from Derck Smits in Pretoria relating to a surplus arising from the 1994 Symposium held in Pretoria. Both these amounts have been posted directly to the Balance Sheet.

Net assets (ie surplus on operations) now stand at R 56000, including the Symposium amount, which has been placed in a separate savings account for the time being.

A healthy position at the halfway mark - but watch this space in the next quarter!
