Honorary Treasurer's Report for the 9 months ended 31 March 2001.

The third quarter of the year has produced a surplus of R3000, derived principally from subscriptions, interest on investments and Star Walks net revenue, with revenue from publications neatly covering their production costs.

Surplus for the year to date now stands at R14000 after writing off R5000 for the supply of badges, which have been well received, by all accounts.

Net worth now totals R75000, of which R41000 is bespoken for the scholarship scheme. It is expected that the last quarter will break even, so the financial year will end up at a level similar to last year.

It is interesting to note that the surplus equates to the total of members' subscriptions.
