**ANNUAL REPORT OF THE UNION OBSERVATORY
JOHANNESBURG**

1945.

(Union Astronomer, Dr. W.H. van den Bos)

With the 26½-inch visual refractor 723 micrometrical measures of double stars were obtained. With the 9-inch visual refractor 87 occultations have been observed.

Dr. H. van Gent took 421 plates almost all of 30 minutes exposure time, of variable star fields and a number of comets with the Franklin-Adams Star Camera.

Mr. C. Jackson resigned on his return from Active Service to become Dr. Alden's successor at the Yale Southern Station, Johannesburg. Mr. E.L. Johnson is still on Active Service. Mr. W.S. Finsen continued to render part-time services to the Directorate of War Supplies.
