






- Booked out 4 months ahead
- SA Museum: mini-planetarium seats c. 16
- Keeps lights out *between* shows
- So white racists won't see Coloureds sitting in the back row & demand apartheid



# Pseudo-science also competes for hearts & minds

- magazine proprietors & editors finger women as soft targets for Eurocentric astrology
- Post-1990: launch new magazines aimed at middle class black women, all indocrinating with astrology columns
- Need to debunk with Copernican revolution



### Astronomy tourism

- Headlines go to 7 billionaire space tourists to space station; next to Virgin Galactic flips
- But 99% space tourism is on the ground
- Over 10 000 tourists per year to SAAO
- Sutherland hotel gets more guests; several B&Bs open
- Sutherland property prices rise higher than other rural towns of the same size
- OTR & ISSA should open for space tours
- eg., Cape Canaveral: 20 buses; 12 ticket kiosks

### Way forward: Policy Recommendations

- Supplement Astronomy Geographic Advantage Act with a national dark sky law, as Czech & Slovenia Republics already have
- Key lobbying point: full cut-off light fixtures mean we can use smaller wattage, save electricity & money
- Astronomy, other space sciences, astronautics must be clustered together for outreach



### Way forward: Policy Recommendations

- SAAO tours limited to middle class who can afford overnight accommodation
- Shuttleworth pioneered mobile S&T show touring 100 schools in 9 provinces
- Need 9 Astronomy-Astronautics mobile S&T shows tours, each touring its province with multilingual edu-tainers
- Work with AU AMCOST to seek donors to start-up
