Enclosed I return the copy of your article on my investigations with one of two trifling verbal alterations. As it stands, it will do quite excellently. Though personally I feel some reductance in publicly announcing results which are still subjudice, especially as they are of a revolutionary character, a kind of astronomical Bolshevism trying to upset the accepted order of things, I take comfort in Dr. Johnson's view that every man has the right of his opinion, but also every other man the right to knock bim down for holding it.
