## HONORARY DEGREE FOR DR GEORGE NICOLSON

Dr George Nicolson, Director of the Hartebeesthoek Radio Astronomy Observatory, was awarded an honorary degree of Doctor of Science by Rhodes University in April.

Nicolson's career began at Hartebeesthoek in 1961 when he joined the staff of the NASA Deep Space Station there. He was responsible for the development of the Station into a radio astronomy observatory when NASA pulled out. He earned his PhD from Wits University in 1975, for a study of the variability and spectra of quasars.

Dr Nicolson was ASSA President in 1985-1986 and received the Gill Medal in 1997.
